#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Zn 9% is recommended to correct zinc deficiencies. Zn 9% should be used on the basis of a soil and/or tissue analysis.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Soil Application: Apply 1-2 qts. of Zn 9% as needed. Formulated and compatible for all use in all liquid suspension fertilizers. Use recommended rates only from a soil or plant analysis where required by law.

Foliar Application: Apply 1-2 qts. of Zn 9% as needed. Apply a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre with the use of Zn 9% to foliage with ground spray equipment.

## **MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Pour 1/3 water or fertilizer into tank
Add other pesticides\*
Fill tank with balance of water or fertilizer
Add Zn 9%
Agitate to assure proper mixing

\*Caution: Check compatibility with orthophosphate fertilizers and other chemicals prior to mixing.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in cool, dry place. Store in original container. Keep container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse, then offer for recycling or for disposal in a sanitary landfill, or by other means in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
