NANO TECH w/ CEC® is effective for both soil and foliar applications. Add **NANO TECH** following other fertilizer inputs (concentrated or blended) in sufficient water to ensure adequate coverage. Mix well. Surfactant products should be added after mixing **NANO TECH** with crop inputs.

APPLICATION RATES

The general use rate for **NANO TECH** is 4-6 fl oz per acre. Apply 6-12 fluid oz per acre for high volume applications (greater than 50 gallons per acre). A reduced rate of 2 fluid oz per acre may be used for low volume aerial applications (less than 5 gallons per acre).
